#### CLIFF'S NOTES

What comes to your mind when you think of the month of June? Your list may include things like: Graduations, the end of the school year, Father's Day? In addition, on June 8<sup>th</sup> we will be celebrating Pentecost. I would remind everyone to wear red that day as we remember the birth of the Church with the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. On June 8<sup>th</sup>, this year's Confirmation Class will be received into church membership. Another activity this June will be the bi-annual meeting of our General Assembly in Detroit, Michigan (June 16-21), I would ask you to be praying for all those who will be attending this important meeting in the life of our denomination. During the month of June we will begin our summer Worship at 10AM, with no Sunday School.

We will also be celebrating Father's Day on June 15<sup>th</sup>. This is a day when we honor our dads and those other significant men in our lives. I have been thinking a lot of my own dad, the last couple of days. You may have heard me share what I affectionately call "Howard's Rules"—those things that my dad conveyed to me as I was growing up. Those rules ran the whole gamut of things like: never leave the Christmas tree lit when you're not home... keep a pair of pants and shirt near you bed in case you have to get out quickly (my dad was a firefighter and he stressed this because at the fire station he had his 'bunker gear' ready to go when the alarm went off)... always have a couple of escape routes planned out if there ever was a fire... never do outside work on Sunday and may others items of practical wisdom. My dad quit school in the 8th grade and went to work shoveling coal, delivering oil, cutting blocks of ice. He worked hard his whole life. Shortly after I was born he was put on the Fire Department on my home town and he also worked a second job on the days when he wasn't on duty. But my dad continued to learn his whole life. He taught Sunday School, was an Elder, and he would preach from time to time. One summer he even had a teacher friend teach him the "new" math so he could help my sister and me with our homework.

I often think of "Howard's Rules". The other day I was reading Psalm 119 and came across these words in verse 105: "Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path." Like my Dad's rules, the word of God helps us in the living of our lives, learning lessons and enable God to mold and shape us into the persons God's wants us to be. So to all those who are fathers (and those who are father figures to others), I want to thank you and to wish you a very Happy Father's Day.
