Session met on December 15, 2014 and reports the following:

- 1) Rev. Foster led us in devotions reading from a Dietrich Bonhoeffer devotional.
- 2) Approved the Clerk's, Treasurer's, and Moderator's Reports
- 3) The next meeting of Redstone Presbytery is set for 1/20/15
- 4) Carol Hohman will serve as our Elder Delegate to the Presbytery Meeting
- 5) The treasurer has distributed worksheets and questionnaires to the various groups to aid in compiling the report to the Office of the General Assembly (OGA)
- 6) Noted that 23 children/youth participated in the Christmas program on 12/14/14
- 7) Noted that there is a "One Day of Fun" scheduled for 12/29/14 as an introduction to the Vacation Bible School program.
- 8) Congregational Life is scheduling a trip to "Winter Jam" on 1/31/15
- 9) Congruity will be hosting the community Vacation Bible School July 20-24, 2015
- 10) Decided to put the Sara Johnston bequest into the New Covenant Building Fund Account
- 11) Noted that \$80 "profit" from the Kid's Store was submitted to the Centsability Offering
- 12) Decided to make up any short fall for our First Fruits Pledge for 2014 from the General Fund
- 13) Set devotional leaders for January, February, and March.
- 14) Decided to send \$100 to the Theological Education Fund from the Local Mission Fund
