Due to the recent flooding, storms, etc, Church World Service has expressed a really great need for hygiene kits, so the Women's Association is collecting either whole kits or items for kits. Each kit contains: 1 hand towel measuring approximately15x28 to16x32 (no fingertip, bath, dish towel or microfiber); 1 washcloth; 1 wide tooth comb removed from package;1 fingernail or toenail clipper removed from package;1 bath size bar of soap in the wrapper; 1 toothbrush in the package; 10 standard size Band-Aids. All items are to fit inside a 1 gallon plastic zipper closure bag. Remove the air from the bag and seal. DO NOT ADD ANY EXTRA ITEMS or TOOTHPASTE! A tube of toothpaste of extended expiration date will be added to each kit prior to it's journey. The kits will be delivered in September on the New Windsor trip.

- 6) Approved summer hours as follows: No Sunday School with Worship at 10 AM starting on 6/5/16 and continuing through 9/4/16. Regular hours for Sunday School and Worship will resume on 9/11/16.
- 7) Granted permission to Mission Partners to place a clothing recycling bin in the church parking lot.
- 8) Appointed a committee to review Congruity's property insurance.
- 9) Kathy Hamilton volunteered to take care of the cemetery planter for the summer.
- 10)Granted permission to the Kaufman's to use the shed behind the church to store their cemetery maintenance equipment.
- 11)Tentatively set July 24th for the summer outdoor worship provided arrangements can be made.
- 12)There was a discussion concerning the cross, candle sticks, and flower vases. Several elders will be looking into options for refurbishing or replacing the items.
- 13)It was decided to try and have the flags in the sanctuary cleaned.
- 14)Noted that a luncheon is being planned for following the Memorial Day service in the cemetery on Sunday 5/29/16
- 15)Noted that Sue Blank will be ordained as a Teaching Elder (Minister of the Word and Sacrament) on Sunday afternoon, June 12th, at Congruity.


PROPERTY COMMITTEE
