

Approved the 2021 statistical report that will be sent to the General Assembly.


Approved The Mission Team's use of Fellowship Hall on March 18 and 19 for a soup sale and take out event.

Next Session meeting is scheduled for February 21, 2022


WOMEN'S ASSOCIATION BY PHYLLIS FRYE
